

On Ash Wednesday Robin started what he is calling “**Manse Mountaineering**”.

Every morning before breakfast he walks up and down a total of more than 400 stairs in the manse. With the two flights of 13 stairs covering a height of 2.6 metres, his plan by Easter Day is to have covered a height equivalent to Ben Nevis, Snowdon and Scafell Pike all combined.

In the first five days of his manse mountaineering Robin managed to clear the height of the Eiffel Tower, and he will aim to give the congregation weekly updates on his ever-increasing altitude Sunday by Sunday.
